



SAFETY, HEALTH AND ENVIRONMENT (SHE) APPRENTICESHIP



WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

By the end of this course you will be able to:

- Assist in the development, management, implementation and monitoring of the Safety, Health and Environmental Management System by updating systems in line with changes in legislation or best practice
- Assist and/or manage the investigation of accidents, incidents, dangerous occurrences and near misses
- Plan and have systems in place to manage change
- Present information or training in an assertive, engaging way
- Work with others well in a team and lead by example in a collaborative way

HOW YOU WILL BE ASSESSED

Assessment of knowledge will be gained through a portfolio of evidence. Delegates will be required to complete elements of self study, which also includes the development of a business case, research project and a presentation. In addition, there are multiple choice and short answer tests to cover the learning in two of the courses (IOSH Managing Safely, IOSH Environment for Business)

DURATION


The apprenticeship will typically last 24 months.

QUALIFICATONS

This apprenticeship is a level 3 and is equivalent to two A-levels. It takes 24 months to complete. Providing the full 24 month journey is completed, IOSH technical membership will be achieved.

PROGRESSION

Following successful completion of the SHE apprenticeship program many SHE Apprentices progress onto higher levels of qualification for example level 6 degree level Diplomas. They also aspire to become Chartered members of IOSH and advance in their career.









The program will deliver the following courses

NCFE IOSH Safety and Health for Business Qualification:

Unit 1: Safety and health management in an organisation

Understand your responsibilities in relation to the safety of yourself and others in the organisation.

The unit also focuses on:

- Planning and monitoring safety and health performance
- Health and well-being
- Health hazards
- Safety hazards
- Good practice

Unit 2: How to influence a safety and health culture in an organisation

Understand organisational culture and techniques that can help develop good practices in safety and health

The unit also focuses on:

- Going beyond compliance
- Human failure in an organisation and how this influences or impacts on safety
- How to deliver positive change within an organisation
- Tackling behavioural and operational challenges to boost business performance

Unit 3: A strategic, business focused approach to safety and health

Understand the main function and aims of an organisation, and how strategic drivers affect it's operation.

The unit also focuses on:

- The impact good practices can have on how an organisation operates
- The added value those practices can bring
- Accountability
- Ethics
- Compliance
- Managing uncertainty
